1. <u>Tertiary Training Project Presentations</u>

The Committee would like to extend their thanks to Brian Guo from the University of Canterbury and Yang Zou from the University of Auckland for presenting their findings to the Committee. Brian and Yang worked alongside Vicente Gonzalez (Committee member) to finalise the research for the Tertiary Training Project. Brian presented on two papers. 1. The BIM Tertiary Education in New Zealand: Status Quo, Gaps and Outlook presentation which investigated the different BIM competencies required to understand the BIM industry, dissolving the deficiencies between the gaps and examining the status quo of BIM tertiary education in New Zealand. 2. BIM learning outcome framework; the research objective was to develop a framework of BIM learning outcomes. Finally, Yang presented, and the aim of this project was to develop an online repository with real BIM cases for NZ industry to support the tertiaries. Copies of the presentations will be published on the BIMinNZ website.

2. BAC Project Updates FY20

Tertiary Training: Vicente Gonzalez, Brian Guo and Yang Zou presented their findings on the BIM tertiary education in New Zealand: Status quo, gaps and outlook, BIM learning Outcome framework and Report for online repository.

BIM Sandpit Model: Project tracking to plan. Project team to migrate the model into the BIMinNZ website and submit and finalise the reports.

Industry Training:

- 1. The project team is looking to condense the BIM 101 handbook referencing the ISO standards.
- 2. 2. The BIM Conference has been postponed due to COVID-19 and will take place Q1 2022

Digital Asset Owners Forum: BAC is establishing an asset owner's forum to help asset owners accelerate their learning by sharing experience and approaches to implementing BIM within

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their organisations and supply chains. The next step is to identify champions to form the core focal point of the forum and confirm asset owners currently delivering BIM vs. want to get started.

Subcontractor Engagement: The project team with delve into how BIM is being used amongst subcontractors drawing on outcomes from previous surveys.

BIM Handbook: The BIM handbook is a long-standing document. Due to the most recent update the Committee have decided that the refresh for 2020/21 will look at updating snippets from the booklet rather than a full refresh.

Industry Organisation: Project on hold.

EBOSS Survey: EBOSS has supported the work of the Acceleration Committee with an annual survey of BIM use for the past 6 years. It is understood this is potentially the longest longitudinal survey of national BIM use in the world. Each survey has had a slightly different approach to the identifying the survey participants. In all cases it has relied on existing networks of committee members. The BAC strategy session in March 2020 questioned whether the next stage in the survey a wider group of users could be, either within the design community, or extending further into the construction and subcontractor parts of the value chain. The Acceleration Committee were updated on preparation for the 2020 survey of BIM users, including proposed changes in the methodology given it appears the current industry group use of BIM has plateaued.

Case Studies: Following the recent refresh of this project the Acceleration Committee have identified three potential case studies to be included on the BIMinNZ website. The next step for the committee is to secure a writer and present the case studies at the Acceleration Committee meetings.

BIM Cost and Value: Project is tracking to plan, Acceleration Committee finalising report which will be uploaded to the BIMinNZ website.

Government Initiatives: Project on hold.

BIM Industry Transformation: Acceleration Committee to prepare project plan.

Metadata Standards: No update.

Next Steps: All Committee members to prepare funding requests for their respective projects.

3. Budget and Programme

FY20 / FY21 Budget tracking to plan. Acceleration Committee were reminded that funding approvals need to be given sufficient time for processing and that the project leaders need to be

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aware of the time constraints when applying for funding. The Acceleration Committee reviewed the updated BIM programme and confirmed that projects are on track.

4. <u>BIMinNZ Website Analytics – June 2020</u>

Visitor numbers for June remained consistent with May sitting at 1100. Across the board there was an increase in visitors to traffic channels, incoming links, outgoing sources, case studies, news articles and BIM Handbook. The Acceleration Committee aims to refresh website content following the outcomes from the case study and BIM handbook.
